### **January 28, 2024 – The Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

As Moses challenged the Israelites to listen to God's voice, so we are called to hear the voice of Jesus and live out his teachings by what we say and do, whatever our vocation in life may be.

**"I Am With You Always!"** is the theme of this year's Diocesan Annual Appeal. "Jesus wants you to experience His love. He invites you to spend time encountering His love in His Eucharistic presence. He wants to speak His words of love to your heart. If you open yourself to Him, He will fill you with His love and I invite you to be generous in your response to Him. As you prayerfully consider supporting this year's DAA, ask the Holy Spirit to show you how you are called to make Christ present by sharing His love through your sacrificial giving to the DAA." – Bishop Cozzens
