Message from Fr. Dave

I will be leaving at the end of this week (Friday, August 12) for a 3 ½ month sabbatical. I will return on Monday, December 5th. Father Raul Perez-Cobo, a priest of our diocese, ordained May 20, 2006, is taking my place. Most recently he was pastor of St. Francis de Sales, Moorhead and St. John's, Georgetown. This year, July 1 to June 30, 2023, he is substituting throughout the diocese. From July 1 until coming here he has substituted at St. Mary's Mission, Red Lake and Sacred Heart, Wilton - for Fr. John Christianson who has been giving Mission Appeals every weekend. After Fr. Raul's time here, he will be able to visit his Family in Columbia. In January he will substitute for another diocesan priest who will be on sabbatical. All this has been approved by Bishop Cozzens and our Diocesan Personnel Board.

I am extremely thankful for this opportunity for rest, a weeklong retreat in Wisconsin in October and time to visit family and friends. I also thank our Parish and School Staff who undoubtedly will take on more responsibility in my absence, and also thanks to Fr. Raul. Please welcome him as you have always welcomed me. Also, please call upon him, as you would your pastor. He is a very compassionate and joyful shepherd.

For clarification's sake, I am still assigned as pastor of St. Michael's and St. Joseph's and am not retiring. Retirement age in our diocese for priests is when you turn 70. I hope to be in our two parishes until that time which would be June 30, 2024. During the next few months, I will be near Mentor, Mn where I hope to reside when I retire on June 30, 2024. So, I guess this will also be a time of practicing for retirement!

You will all be in my prayers and I ask you to keep me in your prayers. Thank you.

FINANCIAL UPDATES

Diocesan Annual Appeal

7-28-22 Report

The Diocesan Goal is at \$910,001.00. To date \$821,848.67 has been pledged and \$747,683.45 has been received in payments. Donors to date = 2800 or 22.5% of diocesan Catholics.

St. Michael's Goal is \$19,983.00. To date \$15,700.00 has been pledged (78.5% of goal) and \$14,550.00 has been received in payments. Donors to date = 62 or 23% of parishioners have made a gift/pledge.

St. Joseph's Goal is \$6,794.00. To date \$8,340.00 has been pledged (123% of goal) with \$7,240.00 received in payments. Donors to date = 20 or 24% of parishioners have made a gift/pledge.
