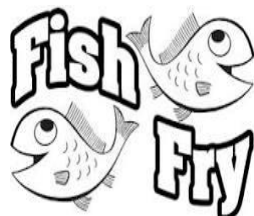

**Financial Overview after 7 months**

***St. Michael's Financial Update*** as January 31st, that is, after 7 months (58.33%) of the 2024-25 Fiscal Year, the Parish Operating Budget is as follows: Income was \$119,903.81 of \$316,401.63 budgeted income (37.90%). Of this income after 7 months, the offertory total (including Sunday and holidays offertories) was \$88,300.23 which is 36.59% of the budgeted Offertory Income. The rest of the revenue came from additional weekly stewardship and special donations. The expenses were \$172,556.52 of \$316,142.16 budgeted expenses (54.58%). Thank you all for your generous support.

So, these figures show us that at this point in our fiscal year, our income is supposed to be at 58.33% of our budgeted income but we are only at 37.90%. Our expenditure is 54.58% so far, which is about where it is supposed to be at this time of the fiscal year. But, if we subtract our total income from our total expenditure so far, we are \$52,652.71 in deficit. This may be partly due to the decline in Mass attendance but also the decline in bigger donations, which we received in the past. Thank you all for your generous support of our parish but as you can see, there is a need to increase our stewardship to help us meet the operating cost of the parish.

***St. Joseph's Financial Update*** as of January 31st, that is, after 7 months (58.33%) of the 2024-2025 Fiscal Year Parish Operating Budget follows: Income was \$79,270.70 of \$96,550.00 budgeted income (82.10%). Expenses were \$78,207.52 of \$93,541.63 (83.60%). Thank you for your generous stewardship.

Expenses were \$310,223.03 of \$515,524.68 budgeted expenses (60.18%).
